Part 1 (5 minutes)

First, I'm going to ask you some questions about yourselves.

(Use the related follow-up questions to encourage Examinees to continue talking)

To Eee. 1

How long have you been studying English? *(Why are you studying English? What for? What will change in your life if your English gets better?)*

How green are you? *(Are you into Ecology? What kind of activities do you do? What is your main concern?)*

Have you ever borrowed / lent money? *(Who from? What for? Are you satisfied with the decision?)*

To Eee 2

How many pets have you owned? *(Which ones? Do you still have pets? Why?)*

Was your weekend as fun as you had hoped? *(Why / Why not? What's a typical weekend like for you? What would be your ideal weekend like?)*

Have you ever bought a useless product? *(What? Why? What did you do with it? What would you recommend to avoid buying a useless product?)*

Part 2 (4 minutes)

Role Play (CARD T 501 A)

To Eee 1: You bought a smartphone last week, but don't like it anymore. You want to get a refund or exchange it for a new one. There's a slight scratch on the screen, though.

To Eee 2: You are the sales assistant of the shop.
