



Stay Safe in Cyber Space

The boom in Technology means that laptops, smartphones and tablets are everywhere. Unfortunately, so are the criminals who are trying to get inside them. Read our security tips to learn how to protect yourself from cybercrime.

Tip 1: Make sure your anti-virus software is up to date. Let it expire before you renew it. Hackers are creating new viruses all the time and only the very latest software can truly protect you.

Tip 2: Get a tracking app. Tablets and smartphone are the perfect target for thieves. Download a tracking app so the police can follow your device and find it.

Tip 3: Use strong passwords. Combinations of numbers and letters are a good idea. Add capital letters too, if you can. Try using your name and birthdays – nobody will guess that! And don't use the same password for multiple accounts.

Tip 4: Click carefully. Don't click on links in e-mails and social networks, especially if you don't know where they came from.

Tip 5: If you can use your device as a Wi-Fi hotspot, protect it with a password and turn off the hotspot when you're not using it. Don't use the Internet at home. This will prevent other people signing in to your network.
